

# Detailed Instructions for Adobe Products and Kindle USB Transfer



## To download For Kindle using USB transfer

If you encounter a book that that says “For Kindle Devices via USB only,” you will need to transfer the book file to your device via a USB cable (it is part of your power cord.) This occurs because of publisher restrictions. Check-out through Overdrive occurs in the same way as a wireless download except you will be asked to confirm which device you are going download to. Before you download the item, connect your device to your computer using the USB cord. Click download. You will then be prompted to save the file and you must choose where to put it. 1. Open My Computer. 2. Look for the Kindle drive (usually f: kindle). 3. Click on the Kindle drive to open it. 4. Find the downloads folder and click to open it. 5. Save the item here. Wait 3 to 5 minutes for the item to transfer, then unplug your device and the item should be on your Kindle home screen. As per manufacturer’s recommendations, always be sure to safely eject the Kindle device from your computer.

## Using Adobe Digital Editions

Nook Glow Light or older models use the Adobe Digital Editions program to manage library e-books. First visit Overdrive and download the Adobe Digital Editions software to your computer. You will find the link to the software at the very bottom of the page under applications. Click on this link and choose “Adobe Digital Editions.” You will be directed to an Adobe page explaining the program. Click on Install Adobe Digital Editions. If you do not already have an Adobe account, you will need to create one. There is no cost but be certain to write down your user name and password because you will need that information again. Once you have set up your Adobe account, you can then click the Download Software button. Follow the onscreen directions on how to save and run the Adobe Digital Editions software. The program will set up a shortcut on your desktop so that you can easily open the program when needed.

You are now ready to download books to your computer. Browse the Overdrive site, being sure to choose books that have the Adobe e-pub option. When you are ready to check out, click the “Borrow” button and you will be directed back to your bookshelf. Choose Download and then choose a format (Adobe e-pub). This will cause Adobe Digital Editions to open and you will see the file download. Now, close the Adobe Editions program, plug in your Nook and then re-open the Adobe program. You will be asked to authorize your Nook for use on the computer. (The first time you do this, you will need to type in your Adobe password.) In the upper left hand corner, click on the icon with three books. This will open the library view of Digital Editions. Place your mouse on the book you have downloaded and drag it to the Nook folder. Wait 3 to 5 minutes for the file to transfer. As per manufacturer’s recommendations, always be sure to safely eject the Nook device from your computer. On your Nook, go to “My B&N Library”. You will find your book in the “My Documents” section.
